“You must come and dine with me today,” he said to the stork, smiling to himself at the trick he was planning to play on him.

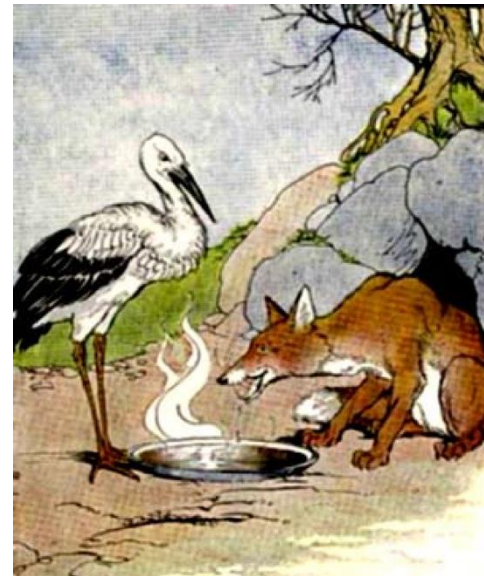
